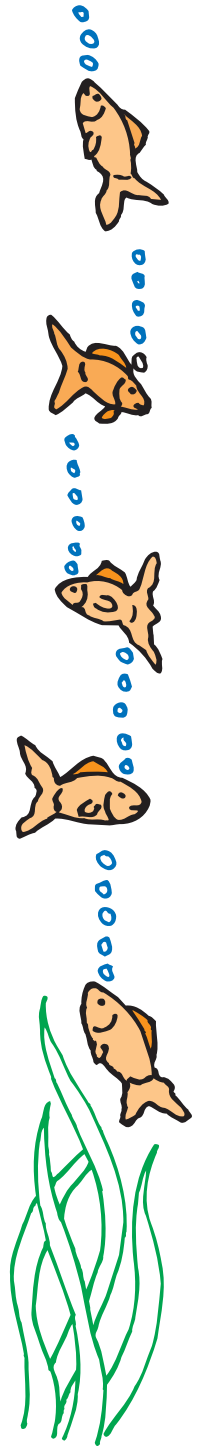
Jadda, jadda, jadda jadda jing, jing jing
